DEACON JOSHUA HARRY JACKSON (96) of York PA, transitioned into his glorified body on Sunday, July 8, 2018 at his home surrounded by his family in York, PA. Deacon Joshua H. Jackson was born on May 10, 1922 to the late Harry and Martha Jackson in Woodville, Va. Deacon Jackson had 15 siblings with one being his twin (Louis). His siblings are Charles, Ruth, Mary, Wilson, Walter, Betsy, Cornelia, Warner, Nellie and Keycell, who all have preceded him in death. Deacon Joshua Jackson (more affectionately known as "Pop" by friends and family) received his education in the Rappahannock County, VA. At the age of 19 Deacon enlisted into the United States Army and fought in World War II receiving several awards and commendations of service. The Good Conduct Medal, American Theater Ribbon and Asiatic Pacific Theater as well as the Bronze Arrowhead World War II Victory Ribbon.

Deacon Jackson was a hard working family man, over his long-blessed life. He held several jobs, Western Electric, Bendex, and Aramark contractor via Lever Brothers. After retiring he went into the landscaping and car detailing business with his late nephew Wyatt Sr. Deacon Jackson "Pop" loved going to church, gardening, traveling, motivational speaking and Americans game of baseball. In addition, Deacon Jackson enjoyed attending and participating at the Crispus Attucks Senior Center. The joy of Deacon Jackson's life was becoming a deacon of the church and serving God with all his heart. In 1986 he was ordained as a deacon at Travelers Rest Bible Church of Baltimore,

MD. After relocating to York, PA due to his health. Deacon Jackson became a deacon at Antioch Church of God of Bible School of Baltimore, MD where he served faithfully until God called him home.

In 1959 he was joined in holy matrimony with the love of his life Gertrude Ramona Jackson, who preceded him in death.
