JOSHUA JOHNSON, son of the late William and Caroline Johnson, was born on November 12, 1926 in Clarendon County, South Carolina. He received his formal education in the public school system of Clarendon County. As a young man Joshua joined the Laurel Hill A.M.E. Church. While there he served as an usher and sang with quartet, the “Happy Land Gospel Singer.”

On April 23, 1949 Joshua married Lula Mae McKiney.. From this union six children were born, three girls and three boys. Three children, Carolyn, Gilbert and Gregory preceded him in death.

In the 1950’s, Joshua and Lula relocated their family to Maryland area. He was employed with George P. Garratt and Sons and worked there for over twenty years until his retirement. To keep busy after retirement he took a part-time job at Bay Island Seafood.
