Joyce E. Marshall, daughter of the late Princeton Guy and Posie Berkley, was born on May 22, 1941 in Richmond, VA. She departed this life on February 16, 2016.

She received her education at Spingarn Senior High School in Washington, D.C. As a teen to help out she earned money as a babysitter. At the age of sixteen, she met a 10th grade athlete from McKinley Tech football team; the late Marvin Marshall. Joyce and Marvin married in 1958; 6 months later their 1st child was born(Duane). She continued to babysit and took up typing classes to prepare herself for a career. In 1960 she had her 2nd child Darryl and five years later in 1965 Darnell was born.

In 1966 Joyce started her professional career in the federal government at the United States Department of Health, Education, and Welfare and Ft. Leslie McNair until she retired in 2003. She resided in the Baltimore, MD area and finally to Largo, MD where she got her call to come home to be with the Lord.

Joyce loved to travel with her three boys up and down the east coast: Mainly to beaches, carnivals, fairs and shopping sprees. She brought a brand new '76 Ford Elite and just loved to adventure out with the boys.
