Juanita Ann Bowman, born Juanita Ann Putney, was born in Gaston, North Carolina on September 5, 1948 to James and Pattie Pntney, Juanita gave her life to Christ at Gaston Baptist Church before moving to Richmond, Virginia at an early age where she attended Richmond Public Schools. Juanita attended AV Norrel Elementary, Benjamin Anderson Graves Middle School and went on to graduate from Maggie L Walker. After completing her education, she married Linwood E. Jones and from that union she had her daughter, Monique L. Thompson. Many years later she married, Gregory M. Bowman, Sr., which she had two sons: Gregory M. Bowman, Jr. and Brian L. Bowman.

Juanita was first employed at her family's cleaners. Later, she began working at Lane Bryant, where she stayed for many years. Afterwards, she worked at M&B Headwear until 1985. Juanita then took time off from working to care for her family until the mid 90's. When she decided to reenter the workforce, she became employed at Hardee's, where she worked her way up from a crew member to a shift manager before retiring.

Juanita was proceeded in death by her mother, Pattie Putney; father, James Putney; and grandson, Jeffrey L. Thompson, Jr.
