Reflection of Life

Juetta Yvonne Matthews Hinton Lane, one of five children of Edward Jr. and Shirley Hinton, was born on December 19, 1948. The family resided in Richmond's historic Jackson Ward Community. Her parents and brother, Carleton Hinton (Estherine, deceased) preceded her in death. Friends and family lovingly referred to Juetta by her nickname of "Cookie". She was heartbroken to lose her daughter, Kimberley Joette Logan in 2006.

She grew up in a Catholic home and accepted Jesus Christ into her life at a very young age. She was a member of the original St. Joseph's Catholic Church where she taught Sunday School for many years as a teenager and young adult. At the dissolution of the original St. Joseph's Catholic Church, she and her parents and siblings later found a permanent home at St. Elizabeth's Catholic Church where she would later raise her daughters.

Juetta received her early education at the affiliated school of Saint Joseph's Catholic Church, Van de Vuyver Parochial School. She later attended public schools and graduated from Maggie L. Walker High School, in 1967, where she was a majorette in the band. Classmates remember her for her calm, sweet disposition and radiant smile. Juetta stayed connected to her high school class mates as she was active in many Maggie L. Walker HS reunions

and events throughout the years. The most recent being in 2017 when they celebrated 50 years.

Juette married the love of her life in 1974 and they raised two children, Kimberley and Kelley. They resided in Hechler Village and the Highland Springs area of Henrico, VA. At the urging of her husband, Juette returned to school to study nursing in 1978-80. She later returned to school to complete her Pharmacology certification as she moved into leadership positions in nursing. Juette also attended Strayer University to study business. Her career in nursing spanned over a 40 year period where she was mostly a Charge Nurse and Nursing Supervisor at long term care and rehabilitation facilities. She also worked in hospital and psychiatric nurse settings throughout her nursing career. Using her dancing skills from "the Ward" and Maggie Walker majorette days, she was a part of a singing/dancing group of 3 nurses, performing in a variety of venues throughout the years. Her health conditions forced her into retirement from professional nursing in early 2020.

Juette continued to be a caregiver after being diagnosed with heart disease, always putting others before herself. She was the primary caregiver for both of her parents until their deaths in 2005 and 2015. She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, sister, aunt, and friend who always helped you to see the good in every situation. Her children and grandchildren remember her as a caregiver and confidante as she was easy to talk to, always encouraging and caring.

She and her husband were "Mom" and "Dad" to many of their daughters' friends. She leaves to cherish her memory her husband of 46 years, Robert A. Lane; one daughter: Kelley Olds (Kevin, Sr.); one son-in-law: Terry Logan; one sister: Jacqueline "Peaches" Jefferson (Cedric); two brothers: Edward "Larry" Hinton, and Marvin Hinton, six grandchildren: Kimetra Thorpe Qustin); Tayla Logan; Kevin, Jr., Kameron, Kennedy, & Kanner Olds; two great-grandchildren: Justin II and Justice; and three surrogate grandchildren:

Anthony, Cameron, and Noah McLauren, and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and lifetime devoted friends.

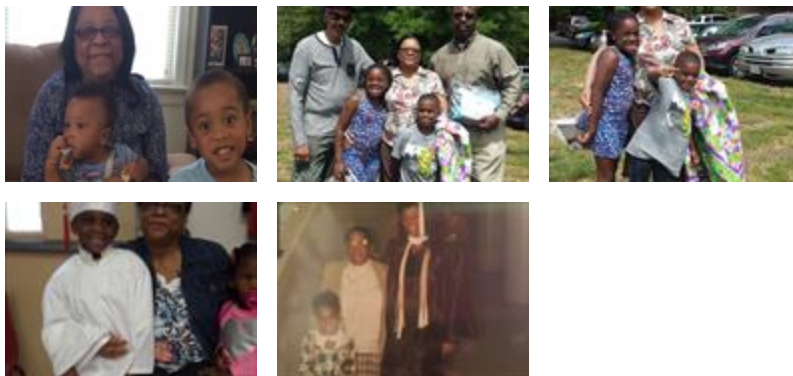
