Julia Mae Stokes, was born on March 15, 1926 in Greenwood, South Carolina, to the late Willie and Novella Fedd. She was the third of seven children born to that union.

At the age of less than one year old, Julia and her family moved to Baltimore, Maryland. She attended public schools of Baltimore city, graduating from Paul Laurence Dunbar High School.
