Julius Williams was born on April 5, 1947 in Warrenton, North Carolina to William H. Williams and Susie V. Williams . He was the first born son of eleven children. Julius departed this life on Saturday, November 5, 2016 as 6:40a.m. at Stella Maris after a lengthy battle with cancer. His father preceded him in death.

Julius, better know as "Pete", wa educated in the public schools of Louisburg, North Carolina. He accepted Christ at a very early age and was baptized at Perry Missionary Baptist Church and later joined the Shocco Chapel Missionary Baptist, where he served on the Usher Board and the Youth Choir.

He later moved to Baltimore, MD. where he worked several jobs, which one was driving a school bus. by his family and friends.

My Daddy is gone now, but the inheritance he left me was priceless, He left me the inheritance of Family.
