June Patricia McIntosh Dougan was born in Port of Spain, Trinidad & Tobago, to Hilda and Joffre McIntosh on June 3rd. 1943. She spent a small part of her childhood in St. Vincent, but largely she grew up in Arima, T&T, where she completed her primary and secondary education at Arima Govt. School and Arima St. Joseph Convent respectively.

June returned to St. Vincent in 1961 where she met her future husband, Raymond. They both migrated to England in 1965 to further their education in Nursing and Construction Management. On October 14th, 1967, June and Ray got married, thus beginning their long and rewarding family life. In 1970, Simone, their first child, was born.

They returned to St. Vincent in 1972, having completed their studies. While there, June worked as a Nurse at Dr. Cyrus's Hospital and in 1975, she gave birth to their second child Miles. The family moved to Trinidad in 1978 and in 1979 Rae-Anne came along.

They remained in Trinidad until 1988 when the family migrated to the USA. The family settled in Rochester where they remained for the next 12 yrs. before moving to Brooklyn in 2001. While in Brooklyn, June worked as a Nurse at the Ruby Weston Manor Nursing Home.

In 2004, their children now grown, June and Ray moved back to St. Vincent where they built a house. They spent their retirement years between St. Vincent and Virginia in the US where they spent time with their children and grandchildren.

June was a loving person with a personality that drew people in and brought out the best in them. She was a loving wife and her “mama bear” protective instincts made her a phenomenal mother. She will be greatly missed by her many friends and relatives.
