Her fine dress carried over to the clothing she bought for her much-adored granddaughters and her daughter-in-law. Addie was baptized at Fellowship Baptist Church in Pomaia, South Carolina. Until she could no longer give and work, she was a faithful member of Zion Baptist Church in Dundalk, MD.
