June Marshall Jones, a retired Social Worker and a retired Caregiver passed away on December 13, 2011. She expired from natural causes at Good Samaritan Hospital.

She was seventy years of age. The daughter of Charles B. and Gertrude O. Marshall, was born on June 8, 1941 and she resided in Baltimore, Maryland her entire life.

She continued full-time employment until her passing at the Good Samaritan Hospital's Nursing Rehabilitation Center.

She enjoyed traveling with her close friends and participated in a number of Senior Citizen related formal and community structured programs.

June was a most beautiful giving person and gave generously of herself to all of her immediate and extended family members, who cover a multitude of persons that she loved, counseled, inspired and incorporated unto herself as a part of her being and every life that she touched. Her marriage of several years to Vernon Raphael Jones ended in divorce.

She leaves behind: a devoted and loving daughter, Robin Jones Straiten; a paternal aunt, Juanita Williams; a sister, Charlita Marshall-Collins; brothers, Charles B. Marshall, Jr., John James Marshall, Don Marshall, Norvan Marshall and Lance Marshall; and a host of nieces and nephews, who were also blessed to have shared her life.
