December 15, 1915 - February 27, 2003

In loving memory of Kate Neemiah Taylor, our beloved mother, who departed this life on February 27, 2003 after an extended illness. Kate Neemiah Lawson was born to the late Lafayette and Martha Lawson on December 15, 1911 in Alton, Virginia. She initially attended school in Alton, Virginia and later in life attended Dunbar High School where she obtained a certificate in Sewing. She worked for Londontown Manufacturing Company as a Presser for 20 years and retired in 1975. Her major hobbies included sewing and raising plants. Kate was a dedicated member of First Apostolic Faith Church for 33 years and faithfully served on the Women Inspirational Choir in excess of 25 years, until her health forbade her.
