She worked for a few years as a teacher's aide at Edgemere Elementary School. After moving to the city, Kathleen joined the Bibleway Baptist Church where she sang in the choir. After her health started declining, she transitioned to Autumn Lake rehabilitation Center on Perring Parkway in Parkville, MD. She made friends with the staff and looked out for other residents. Kitty was a one-woman resident welcoming committee and was often stationed at the front desk. She was a self-elected Sheriff. She knew who was coming and going. Kitty was a sharpshooter with a BB gun and could fry a fish golden brown. She loved chicken boxes, gingersnaps, chips and sodas. She was the town crier and had to have a new watch every Christmas. She also liked nice clothes and new purses with loose change for the vending machines. Kitty walked through this life being mindful of her faith

and trusting GOD.

Kitty will be missed but fondly remembered by all who knew her. Her passing, though a certain time for rejoicing in heaven, leaves a great void in the lives of all who loved her. Kathleen leaves to cherish her memory Aunt Martha, a special cousin Howard, two special caretakers Gwendolyn and Adrienne and a host of cousins and friends.
