She retired from Baltimore City Schools as a Master Teacher where she educated and nurtured thousands of young students and teachers. Her impact on our community will be felt for many generations as she enjoyed the admiration and respect of everyone she impacted.

Kathleen was totally dedicated to her family and could always be depended upon to offer sage advice and council to young and old alike. She and her "John" made it a point to enjoy each other during their 46 years of blissful marriage with date nights attending nearly every new movie as it was
