December 30, 1992 - September 12, 2020

Kenneth Torrence Bivens, nicknamed “Sweat”, son of Torrence Bivens and Donna Douglas, raised by Wanda Bivens, was born on December 30, 1992. At 27, he departed this life, tragically, on September 12, 2020 after succumbing to a fatal injury.

Kenneth Bivens received his education from the Baltimore Archdiocesan Catholic School System: St. Mary’s and St. Catherine Grammar Schools. After completing high school at St. Frances Academy, he attended the University of Maryland, Eastern Shore to pursue further education.

Several years later, Kenneth returned home to enter the work force. Kenneth worked several jobs before landing a position with the MDH service staff, working for the Maryland State Government at Spring Grove Hospital Center.

Kenneth was baptized and gave his life to Jesus Christ. In May of 2001, he became a member of Bethel AME Church, Baltimore, Maryland. During those years, Kenneth served with the Bethel Junior Usher Board. Kenneth attended regular church services at Bethel and always preferred to sit in the balcony.

Kenneth knew the Lord and always would say, “This is the day the Lord

has made. Let us rejoice and be glad in it.”

Wherever he went, Kenneth, a compassionate young man, made numerous friends. One of his favorite pastimes was playing PlayStation with his friends. Kenneth also maintained a passion for sports, his favorite being baseball. During his tenure at St. Frances Academy, he played football (#44) and baseball as an outfielder. He helped Saint Frances Academy secure the 2009 conference championship. Kenneth also loved to watch sports on ESPN.

A devoted family member, Kenneth will be missed. He leaves behind many to mourn: Torrence Bivens, Donna Douglas and Wanda Bivens; sisters, Kimmie, Neicy, Daisy, Jean and Jordan; brothers, Maurice, Floyd and Jobi. He also leaves special friend, Mary Malloy, nieces, nephews and a host of other relatives and friends.
