Kenneth William (Pee Wee) Nell, Jr., was born on June 24, 1950 in Charleston, South Carolina to Zelene Grant Nell and Kenneth Nell. He died July 3, 2002 at his home near the Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore. He grew up in the Pimlico section of Baltimore, attending Forest Park High School and later, Hagerstown Community College and Towson State University. He enlisted in the United States Army and served in Viet Nam. Like so many young men of his generation, he returned from Viet Nam a changed person. Despite his own challenges, he was an adult literacy volunteer and he devoted himself to visiting residents in VA hospitals, writing letters for them and cutting their hair. He is survived by his long time companion, Barbara Conte; one son, Dominic Kenneth Nell; his mother, Zelene Nell-Hudnell of Riverview, Florida; a sister, Lillian O'Neill Dunning of Riverview, Florida; a brother, Carl Hudnell, Jr., of Palmetto, Florida; a sister, Carol Hudnell of Tampa, Florida; and a large extended family.
