“ As I sit here and look at Kenyon's picture in the left corner, my eyes fill with tears that I'm fighting not to shed. It was December 2004 when I learned about Kenyon's passing from a friend. I just burst out into tears uncontrollably. I knew of the life he used to live, but I was relieved when I found out from a mutual friend that he was changing for the better. He had a good job and actually was settling down with a nice young woman. Kenyon was very significant in my life growing up; I considered him "my first love". I moved away from Hayward & Nelson in 1995, but Kenyon and I remained in touch for a long while, then once I went to College out of state, we lost touch, but I'd still inquire about him from time-to-time with our mutual friends. I remember always wearing his horseshoe ring; I loved that ring. I remember that if we weren't together, we'd be on the phone. I remember the first time he told me he loved me, we were kids I know, but I could tell he meant it -even if it was "kiddie love". I remember his brother Nick playing matchmaker for us and I remember my mom coming out of my house and seeing us sitting on the porch with his arm around me. She told him, "Hands off!" and he slowly eased his arm from around me. Him and Nick left that day, and that was the LAST TIME he came on my porch. That was fine, because I just walked up Nelson and chilled with him wherever he was. I remember his grandparents, and how warm and receptive they were when Kenyon first brought me to his home where he lived with them. I still have the tape I made after we broke up May 13, 1993 with love songs and songs that reminded me of him. I know his abrupt passing waged heavy on many. His family, friends, and children will forever be in my prayers. I knew he had a son named after him, but didn't know about his daughter - what a Blessing! For a long time I had wanted to name my first daughter after Kenyon, Kenyonna, but that has sense changed, even though his place in my heart has not. I still can not believe he has been taken from us; I always thought he'd be around, but I have the memories and pictures that will last me until I'm with him again.
