



## Kerine Carmen Seivewright

March 29, 1936 - November 4, 2025

Mother Kerine Seivewright (aka Ms. Kerine) was born on March 29, 1936 in Hanover, Jamaica to the late Theresa Facey and Norman Davis. On November 4, 2025 Mother Seivewright went home to be with her Lord and Savior.

Mother Seivewright, as she was affectionally known, accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior in her early adult years while visiting Canada. She truly loved God and was a devoted servant, steadfast in her daily devotions, prayer and study of the Word of God.

The first of seven children, Mother Seivewright was preceded in death by her parents Theresa Facey and Norman Davis, brother Roy Facey, sister Doris Facey, and brother Lee Moore.

Mother Seivewright received her basic education from Jamal, located in Jamaica, WI. In 1988 Mother Seivewright journeyed to the United States. While in the U.S. She received a certificate as a Home Health Aid in New York. She worked with various clients until she retired in 2005.

Mother Seivewright loved to knit and sew.

In 1964 Mother Seivewright met and married the Love of her life, Isaac

Seivewright. They remained married for 58 years until her husband went on to be with the Lord. From this union 3 children was birthed, her son Leon Wedderburn, and twin daughters, Julia and Juliette.

In her early years, Mother Seivewright and her husband Isaac traveled to the Bahamas and Canada as domestic workers. She returned to Jamaica to birth her twin girls Julia and Juliette in 1970.

Following her nurturing years with her twin daughters, Mother Seivewright traveled back to Canada to work. It was in Canada that she gave her life to the Lord. That was the Genesis of her christian life. However, when she returned to her homeland in Jamaica in 1977 she became a member of Logwood Church of God, Ground of truth Church. There she served faithfully under the Pastorate of the late Bishop Martell Facey. Mother Seivewright was a committed servant to the cooking convention, the prayer band, and the Women's Department. It was there that Mother Seivewright matured in her christian experience.

In 1988 Mother Seivewright moved back to the U.S. to Brooklyn, New York. She joined the Full-Gospel Tabernacle of Faith Church under the Pastorate of the late Bishop Samuels. There she became the mother of the church. She was very much loved by all the members and was faithfully committed to the ministry until she relocated back to Jamaica.

Between the years of 2015 and 2024, Mother Seivewright traveled extensively between Jamaica and the U.S. She spent time with her daughters Julia and Juliette, and they cared for her as her physical health was declining.

In 2024 she returned to the U.S. to spend her final days with her daughter Julia and her son in law Vincent. She also rejoined her former church Words to Life Ministries. She loved her pastor, Bishop Charles E. Smith, Sr. All of the

members loved, honored and prayed for. She will be deeply missed.
