Kermit Williams was born to Ola Bell Williams and James Oliver Williams on Monday, November 20, 1950 in Baltimore, MD. He departed on Saturday, July 18, 2015 at 4:35 p.m.

In 1968, Kermit received a full scholarship to attend Frederick Douglass Journalism School in New York, which he attended from 1968-1970. He was one of forty people in the country to receive this award. Kermit moved to Detroit, Michigan in 1975 where he resided for most of his adult life. He started working for General Motors in 1975 as a Logistics Manager where he worked for several years. He later moved to Indianapolis, Indiana where he worked as a manager for Village Pantry for four years. In 1978, Kermit married his former wife, Shirley, and their union produced a beautiful baby boy, Brandon Williams, born on Thanksgiving Day, November 24, 1983 Kermit was also stepdad to Shirley's son, Sean, who was six years old when Brandon was born.

In early 2005, Kermit moved back to Baltimore to look after his father after his mom died. In 2011, Kermit moved to Myrtle Beach, SC and lived there until March of this year.

In his early days, Kermit was dapper dresser, having a cap to match every outfit, with his belt and socks so elegantly coordinated. Most recently, he

developed a fondness for sushi. Kermit was very generous and giving and was a hopeless romantic.
