



Kevin Maurice Chew

March 21, 1958 - March 12, 2011

KEVIN MAURICE CHEW, affectionately known by many as simply “Chew,” was born on Friday, March 21, 1958 to proud parents, Reginald and Shirley Taylor.

Chew was an affectionate, inquisitive child who shared an early interest in reading and sports. In his formative years he was a favorite of his maternal great-grandfather, Charles “Papa” Chew, who shared his leftover dinner with Chew for snacks while catching the Baltimore Orioles baseball game on the radio.

Papa was a tremendous influence on Chew, teaching him The Lord Prayer and how to tie his shoes. Chew was an eager and engaged student in the Baltimore Public Schools where he played team sports and excelled academically at his beloved alma mater, Frederick Douglass High School. At a very young age, Chew earned a reputation as a quick-witted, no-holds-barred comedian who many have missed his professional calling. There as never a dull moment when Chew was in the room. At the same time Chew was a compassionate, family-loving person with a warm heart who could be generous to a fault. He would give you the shirt off back. His intelligence and congeniality earned him a succession of managerial and supervisory positions in healthcare and building maintenance during his career, until his illness forced him to stop working. Chew’s illness continued to limit his physical ability

and would eventually overwhelm him. God called Chew home in the early morning hours of March 12, 2011; nine days shy of his fifty-third birthday.

He leaves to mourn: his wife, Kennetha Latonya Chew; his only child, beloved daughter, Kenisha Latanya Chew; his mother, Shirley Taylor (he was preceded in death by his father, Reginald Taylor); his brothers and sisters, Darnell Hebron (Carlette), Sara Colbert, Regi Taylor, Jr. (Yvonne), Johnny Lee Williams and Roy Lee Williams, Arlene Harris, Tina Busby (Conrad) and Tanya Williams (Ronald); godmother, Gertrude Hawkins; godsister, Mary Moore; special aunt uncle, Eva and Leo Hollinsworth; and a host of other relatives and friends.

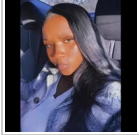
