



Kevin D. Beard

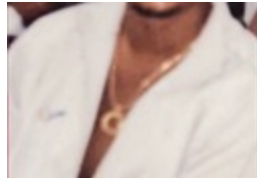

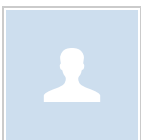
