He began his education in the Catholic school system and continued it in the Baltimore City Public School System where he received his high school diploma. Kevin was a very well-mannered, handsome, charming, and talented man. While attending Mount Royal Middle School, he developed an interest in writing, which laid the foundation for his passion for music. Kevin embraced his passion for music and began writing lyrics at the age of sixteen. With a passion for music, coupled with his dedication to his vision, Kevin began performing locally, developed several videos that are currently on YouTube and was recently interviewed on one of Atlanta's hottest stations for new "Rap Artists".

Kevin was very close to his mother and would often consult with her regarding his vision, the meaning of life and the purpose for developing and maintaining a relationship with "God". At a very young age Kevin was baptized at Lynden Hall Baptist Church and attended Sunday school on a regular basis. Later on he would occasionally attend First Charity Baptist Church with his father. Kevin's consciousness of his relationship with God was evident in his lyrics which made reference to God's grace and mercy. After his mother's transition,

Kevin made it his mission to make his mother proud of him and he wrote "Momma Cries" in honor of his mother and his endless love for her.

On July 29, 2010, his pride and joy Kevin Jr. was born, forever changing his life. Kevin was a great father to K.J., he wanted to teach him everything, from reading and singing his ABC's to good manners, such as saying "Please" and "Thank You." Kevin wanted to make sure manners and respect was instilled into KJ's development and that he would be well grounded in later years. He loved his son with all of his heart and he wanted to be the model of manhood for KJ to love and respect.
