KEVIN LAMONT MCIVER, son of Joseph H Sr. and the late Patricia J. McIver was born September 15, 1964 at Alleghany General Hospital in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He departed to Omegaland on Thursday, September 30, 2009 after a lengthy illness. He received his high school diploma from Peabody High School in Pittsburgh and earned a Bachelors of Science degree in Business Administration from Morgan State University in 1986. While at Peabody, Kevin started as point guard on the 1982 Pittsburgh Public School City Championship Basketball team and received a basketball scholarship to Morgan State University. During his tenure at Morgan Kevin pledged Omega Psi Phi Fraternity in 1983. Upon completion of his education, he became a full-time employee in the office of Enrollment Services at Johns Hopkins University. During that time he was able to serve as an Assistant Basketball Coach for the Johns Hopkins Greyhounds under the direction of Coach Bill Nelson. After eight years with the Greyhounds, Kevin gained employment with Howard Community College as the Head Basketball Coach. Under his leadership, Howard Community College played to the State Regional Championship game for the first time and won more games than anytime in school history. He married the former Peggy Diggs in 1987 and one of his greatest joys was the time he spend raising his son, Kevin. He coached Kevin in Baseball, Football and Basketball and was his son's number one fan. Kevin always carried a smile on his face and never let people know the illness he dealt with for over 20 years. He made numerous friends wherever he went

and was a devoted Man of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity.
