Kevin Lee White, Sr., was born July 29, 1969, to the late Odessa E. White in Washington, DC. As a toddler, he was relocated to Richmond, VA where he was raised by E. Jewel Harrison and the late Horace E. Harrison. Kevin attended Richmond Public Schools, graduating from John F. Kennedy High School in 1987. He completed several years of college before landing a programming position with Microsoft, Inc.

Kevin continued to develop his business acumen while working for various companies over the years, before establishing his own business enterprise. As Founder and CEO of The Ithiel Group, Kevin was licensed to open his first group home, Harrison House in 2009. He continued to grow and expand his operation, providing residential, counseling and support services to individuals with intellectual disabilities and others in need of mental health care. With his vision and the support of a dedicated team, Kevin was able to expand his businesses throughout the Richmond and Tidewater areas. Kevin had a compassionate heart for and a special rapport with people in need. His clients of all intellectual levels responded to him well.

Having a robust gift for gab and little concept of time, Kevin enjoyed “chopping it up” with anyone who would engage in conversation or debate, at any hour of day or night. He was a complexed man who sometimes made his world more difficult than it needed to be, but he loved without fail his family and his

friends. Kevin was raised to know the Lord and he was kind and generous to those less fortunate. He persevered through serious health challenges, business detours and social hurdles, until the Lord quietly called him home August 19 , 2025.

He leaves to carry on his legacy and to cherish his memory adopted mother E. Jewel Harrison; children Shanika Stubbs, Kiara Stubbs, Destiny Milton and Kevin L. White, Jr.; grandson Kayden Stubbs; a host of cousins, colleagues and devoted friends
