Kevin Deneal Winston, beloved father, grandfather, brother, and friend, was born on September 25, 1954, in Baltimore, Maryland, to the late Iris P. Davis and Daniel Winston. He received his education in the Baltimore City Public School System and proudly graduated from Northwestern High School in 1972.

Kevin continued his education at Salisbury University, where he was a member of the first chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. He also attended Essex Community College, where he earned an associate degree in arts. While at Essex, he was an active student-athlete, participating in basketball and track and field as a discus thrower, and was a member of the Black Student Union.

In 1977, Kevin gave his life to Christ and was baptized at Galilee Baptist Church. In July 1978, he married Lorita Gardner, and from this union were born two children, Keith Winston and Chiara Bey.

Kevin dedicated 40 years of service to Johns Hopkins University, where he worked in shipping and receiving. He was also passionate about sports and officiated as a referee for football and basketball and served as an umpire for softball. Outside of work, Kevin cherished spending time with family and friends and found joy in hand dancing with the Hand 2 Hand dance group.

Faith and church family remained an important part of Kevin's life.

He worshipped alongside his mother at John Wesley United Methodist Church, where he faithfully served as an armor bearer for six years and was a devoted member of the Men's Choir. As his health declined, attending church became more challenging; however, his faith remained steadfast. On February 18, 2026, God saw fit to call Kevin home.

Kevin leaves to cherish his memory his loving children, Keith Winston (Kimberly) and Chiara Bey (Dwayne); eleven grandchildren: Kyeona, Keith Jr., Dashawn, Deon, Amya, Jerell, Jabrea, Donovan, Jonathan, Diara, and Madison; and his siblings, Kurt Davis, Janice Davis, James Davis Jr., Robert Davis, and Carolyn Brown. He was preceded in death by his brother, Kenneth Davis, and his sister, Denise Allen. along with a host of other beloved family members and friends.
