“*Kimberly’s passing is a deep loss for all who knew her – her family most of all, her colleagues at AIM and AIM’s clients, her friends. She is deeply missed. I first met her at AIM several years ago and knew her as the person in charge of transportation at AIM, the senior center without walls in north Baltimore. When she booked a ride for you to your doctor, you knew the transport would happen. Kim followed through on everything she did; she was a master of details. A few times we clashed about scheduled rides, but I soon learned she was right more often than I was. She was forgiving of my failing memory. She was tough but there was a kindness to her. But just focusing on her role with transportation is too narrow. Kim was a force of nature. Early to work and late to leave, Kimberly helped a variety of activities for seniors be a success. She drove a busload of seniors several times a month to sample different restaurants, and tracked the individual meal costs for everyone. She could be seen in the main room at AIM unloading farm produce for distribution to seniors. At IRS time, Kimberly helped with the team providing assistance with tax returns. She was there making sure everything went smoothly when guest speakers came for a talk. She oversaw AIM’s special holiday events in the Keswick auditorium – and was managing the activities at AIM’s picnic in the summer. These are only small samples of what Kimberly did for seniors at AIM to make their experience special; she was tireless, sensible and smart. I had so much respect for her – and gratitude for her presence at AIM. My condolences to her family. Rest in peace, Kimberly.*
