If Kesha was not working for a specific company, you could always find her babysitting her little cousins or children of the family and of friends. A year after graduating from Northern High School in 1994, Kesha enlisted in the US Armed Forces. While Serving as an Automated Logistic Specialist in the Army, Kesha was able to travel to such places as South Carolina, Korea, Louisiana, Bosnia and finally to Kentucky. The attack on Kesha's health began in Kentucky where she elected to stay for most of her illness. After finally persuading her to come back to Baltimore, she continued to rely more heavily on her unwavering faith in God rather than on the knowledge of the medical profession. As such, she considered hospitalization to be an obvious demonstration of doubt, fear and disbelief. Knowing how strong her faith and belief in God was, her wishes were honored as much as possible and she was allowed to go on to be with Her Lord and Savior to a place where the wicked shall cease from troubling and the weary shall be at rest, and all the Saints (that includes Kesha) and the Angels shall sit at his

feet and be blessed.
