Lamont passed away suddenly in his home in Washington, D.C., Thursday, February 18, 2016. Beloved son of Robert and Sallie Shaw was born in Richmond, VA June 23, 1956. Lamont attended grade school in Richmond Public Schools. He completed his education in Newark, New Jersey. After which, he joined the U.S. Marine Corp and completed his basic training in Parris Island, South Carolina.

At an early age, Lamont and his three brothers were baptized together by Rev. E. C. Kent at Mount Olivet Baptist Church, Richmond, Virginia. His roommate Andre Moore stated, "There was never a dull moment with Lamont around the house. He was my Buddy. We had so much fun..."
