Larry attended the Richmond Public school system, graduating from Armstrong High School in 1964. Larry joined the United States Air Force (USAF) on June 1, 1969. While in the USAF he earned the rank of Sergeant and was honorably discharged on August 17, 1973. Larry's service to the United States included time spent in Taiwan and Vietnam.

Larry met and fell in love with Shirley Temple Macon. They married on August 10, 1974 in New Kent, Virginia.
