LARRY STANLEY WRIGHT SR., son of Geraldine Wright and the late Lindbergh Wright, was born March 13, 1963 in Baltimore, Maryland. He received his education in the public school system of Baltimore City. Larry was employed in the Baltimore area at Tomkin Steel Company and Rockland Industries where he worked until his health failed him in 2005. He was an avid sports fan, especially basketball, football and pitching horseshoes. He will always be remembered for his outgoingness, free hearted personality and courteous mannerism. Larry could not stand by and see someone struggling and not lend a hand. Whenever he was in the presence of others, his smile and laughter would overwhelm you. Larry was known by some of his close friends as Reds or Shorty Reds. Most of all, Larry was proud to be a Wright. Larry was raised and lived most of his life in East Baltimore, but later moved to Turner Station, Dundalk, Maryland where he resided for seventeen years until his passing on. He was baptized at New Shiloh Baptist Church in Turner Station, where he served faithfully on the Usher Board and the Male Chorus. Sometime later in 2001 Larry and his friend Angela, both joined Saint Matthews Methodist Church, located in Turner Station. He leaves to cherish his memory: his mother, Geraldine Wright; two sons, Larry Stanley Wright Jr. and Antwion Stanley Wright; special friend, Angela Sneed and her two sons, Demetrius and Joseph Paul Michael Sneed; sister, Rochelle A.
