December 5, 1915 - January 16, 2012

LAURA MAGDELENE HOLLAND ONLEY was born in Burkittsville, Maryland on December 5, 1915 to the late Madora Smothers Holland and Albert John Dorsey Holland. She was the seventh of twelve children and the last of her siblings. She departed the life on January 16, 2012 after a brief illness.

Laura attended Horsey School, a one-room schoolhouse, until the seventh grade. She married John Wesley Marshall and two children were born of the union, Ronald Joseph Marshall and Michael Wesley Marshall. The Second World War caused problems for John and Laura; subsequently, they were divorced. Laura married Raymond Onley who she had known since childhood. He was killed in a tragic automobile accident in 1969.

Laura worked hard all her life. She worked nights at the United States Post Office to insure the safety of her sons during the day. Later, she worked at The United States Bureau of Engraving and Printing, took night classes and graduated high school. She also worked At Fort Meade and at Maryland Department of Employment Security.

She participated in various activities of Saint Pius V Church. At one time she sang o the choir. She served as a Eucharistic Minister which she enjoyed immensely. She led the church in saying the rosary. Also, she was a member of the Sodality. She received the Mary Elizabeth Lang Leadership Award from

the Archbishop of Baltimore.

Laura loved bingo. For many years, she always attended the church bingo on Monday nights. Also, she was an avid pinochle player, taking great pleasure in winning over her opponents.

She leaves to mourn: two loving and devoted sons, Ronald and Michael and their wives, Margaret and Shallie Marshall; five grandchildren and their spouses, Michael Antnes (Denise), Marcia Epps (Wayne), Donna Marshall, Marjorie Willis (Ian) and Robert Marshall (Wendy). Also mourning her are twelve great-grandchildren, host of nieces, nephews, friends and relatives.
