Quietly in the early morning hours on Sunday, December 18, 2011, LAURA JACQUELYN JONES began her journey to be with the Lord after a lengthy illness. She was born on November 1, 1934 in Berryton, Georgia to the late Walter and Mabel (Finley) Jones. She was preceded in death by her son, James Kevin Jones and one brother, Benjamin Garland Jones.

Laura was a member of the Paul Laurence Dunbar High School February 1953 graduating class. She also earned an Associate of Arts Degree from Catonsville Community College.

Laura was employed with the State of Maryland — Maryland Correctional Institution for Women in Jessup, Maryland. She retired in 1993 as a captain.

“Jack” as she was affectionately known, has been a member of the First Christian Community Baptist Church since Holabird. She was a very dedicated worker for the building of God’s kingdom. She was a member of the Gospel Choir, Senior Choir and Mass Choir. Her love of singing often allowed her to do many lead parts and solos. She also served as a Trustee, Women’s Day Chairlady for numerous years and then Financial Secretary until her passing. Jack’s star quality performance with the Drama Ministry in the play “The Great White Throne” gained her the recognition as “Mama Jack.”

Jack had a love for her family but her heart was centered around her grandchildren Wesley and Taylor. She also enjoyed the role as Godmother

to many.
