Lavern Vanessa Mebane was born August 22, 1957 in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Pearl Locks and Henry Jones. She spent most of her adolescent years living in the Park Heights community with many memorable moments in the house on Cottage Avenue.

Lavern attended Baltimore City Public Schools graduating from Frederick Douglass Senior High. At the age of 16 she began to work at the Konstant Hot-Dog Stand at Lexington Market. She worked there until the age of 20, and then began her career at Rosewood State Hospital until retiring after 30 years of service.

In 1980, Lavern met the handsome and amazing Charles “Charlie” Mebane who gave her all her hearts desires. In 1982 they married. From that union they would have two children who Lavern thought the world of, Brian and Crystal Mebane. This union lasted 37 years until Charlie was called home to be with the Lord.

Lavern loved life and had no problem living it. She loved music and would jump at the opportunity to host or help plan a party or in her case “AN EVENT”. She was truly the Boss, not Bossy, but the person you would go to if you needed to know how to get things done.

On December 12, 2022, Lavern passed away after a lengthy battle with renal failure. Lavern gracefully endured many treatments and hospitalizations due to the illness in hopes of just feeling good enough to enjoy her family. On December 4, while attending Sunday service at Empowerment Temple, Lavern received a call from Johns Hopkins Hospital that they had finally found a kidney replacement. The surgery went well and she was looking forward to coming home when things took a turn for the worst causing her transition to be with the Lord.

Lavern was preceded in death by her husband, Charles Mebane and two brothers, Edgar and Tyrone Locks.
