LaVerne Sharnae Pleasant was born to the late Pompey and Juanita Cox on July 3, 1951 in Charles City County, VA, where she attended Public Schools and graduated from Ruthville High School in 1969. She wed the love of her life, Jerry L. Pleasant, Sr. on June 20th, 1973 and for 43 years, she was both his partner in love...and in life. LaVerne also enjoyed a successful and fulfilling career with Bon Secours/St. Mary's Hospital where she served from 1970 to 2015.

LaVerne joined New Vine Baptist Church at an early age and was a member of the Missionary Board. In 1984 her husband took her to get bowling lessons to try to get her away from Bingo, little did he know all the time she would invest, the lives she would touch and the recognition she would receive from this decision. She was Secretary of the Odds & Ends Bowling League for 25 years, inducted into both the USBC and TNBA Halls of Fame, bowled a perfect 300 game, and created The Messengers Bowling Group.
