For example, as a wrestling mom, she cheered at countless wrestling matches and tournaments, supporting her two sons and beloved nephew, Tyrone Bowie, Jr. In addition, she loved good music, dancing and devouring the infamous "Maryland Crab." Lavern was preceded in death by her loving mother, Rose L. 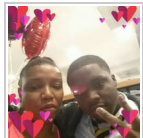
