Lawrence Stuart Duncan, known as Larry, passed away peacefully on June 4, 2019 in Baltimore, MD after a lengthy illness. He was surrounded by family and friends.

Larry was born to Barbara Alves Duncan and Percival Duncan, Sr. on March 10, 1956 in Kingston, Jamaica, where he spent his early years. When he was 13 years old, Larry moved to the United States, and eventually settled in Detroit, MI, where he lived with his paternal uncle, Leopold Duncan.

After graduating from Saint Martin Deporres High School in Detroit in 1974, he moved to Brooklyn, NY, where he worked in a family-owned food market. In 1979, he moved to Maryland where he worked as the lead machine operator for eight years with Koppers Piston Ring and Shaft Seal Corporation. Afterwards, he worked for UPS from which he retired after 16 years and for Howard County, Maryland Government where he worked for 25 years.

Larry developed a lifelong passion for cars at an early age and owned several auto garages and a tow truck business. His hobbies were welding, fishing, biking, listening to music and attending auctions. He especially loved buying and selling cars. He also collected rare cars, exotic car parts and antiques.

Larry was naturally gregarious and made numerous friends wherever he went

and never failed to help people who were less fortunate than himself. He was a true friend who was loved by many and a devoted father and grandfather.

Larry was predeceased by his parents and beloved uncle. 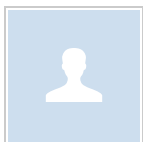
