Leatrice Butler (nee Barnes), beloved daughter of the late Samuel Butts and Geneva Barnes, and stepdaughter of the late Orsborn Barnes, was born on July 29, 1929 in Baltimore, Maryland. She departed this life on May 2, 2002 after a lengthy illness. She attended Baltimore Public Schools until her senior years and her mother's illness, when she had to be on call to give her medicine until her demise. She was united in marriage to the late John H. Butler in 1957. From this union two sons were born John and Wayne. During her youth, Leatrice visited both Baptist and Methodist churches, but she finally joined the membership of St. James United Methodist Church.
