Lee Royal Anderson was born on February 22, 1924, in Baltimore City, Maryland. He departed this life peacefully at home during the early morning hours on Tuesday, August 16, 2016.

Affectionately known as "Leroy" or "Royal", he was the third child of five children born to the late Leach and Polly Anderson. He was preceded in death by his siblings Gladys, Bernard, Lotina and Frieda. Royal and his cousins, Mary Ross, Raymond, Jerome and Ronald Oliver, were more like siblings than cousins and they shared many fond memories and good times.

Royal was educated in the Baltimore City Public Schools. He enlisted in the United States Army at Fort Holabird, Maryland. He served in Germany post World War II and earned several medals after obtaining the rank of Corporal. He was honorably discharged on September 25, 1953.

He married his childhood sweetheart, Elizabeth Olivia Carver. From this union Kimberley Ann Anderson was born and he became the father of Elizabeth's son, James Manns.

Royal worked for Bethlehem Steel for thirty years and was a gifted selfemployed

carpenter. He loved doing home repairs. He loved to talk and had an engaging personality. He had a funny wit and loved telling stories. He was a devout Christian and was baptized at Southern Baptist Church.

Lee Royal Anderson and Gwendolyn Lee Tubman were united in holy matrimony on November 18, 1994 in Baltimore, Maryland.
