LEE ANDREW KNIGHT, son of the late Hattie Mae Craig and George Knight was born in June 17, 1932 in Orrville, Alabama.

He received his education in the Public School System in Orrville, Alabama. He received his bachelor's of Arts Degree in Business from Booker T. Washington Business College in Birmingham, Alabama.

Lee accepted Christ as a young adult. Later he moved his family to Baltimore, Maryland and joined First Christian Community Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Ernest Humphey who often referred to him as a "crook." Lee was a Sunday School teacher for the adult class for several years.

He was adamant about his children growing up in the church and having a personal relationship with God. Lee had a passion for life and he lived it to the fullest. His uncanny use of words often left you thinking. Lee enjoyed making chess sets. He created various types of chess sets for dignitaries like Former Mayor Kurt Schmoke, Governor William Donald Schaffer, WJZ Marty Bass who featured Lee on the Morning Show and Brother Lee Michaels from Heaven 600 who did several radio interviews.

He was a talented artist and enjoyed drawing and coloring cartoon characters.

Lee was a bold and fearless man of God who often spoke his mind. Lee served in the United States Army during the Korean War. He was the recipient of the Silver Star, Bronze Star and Purple Heart.

He leaves to cherish his memory: his loving wife of forty-two years, Doris; one son, Delrick of Edenton, North Carolina; eight daughters, Patricia (Albert) of New York, Sandra of Summit, Mississippi, Marilyn (James preceded in death), Pecola (preceded in death), Annette (Kepler) of Boston, Massachusetts, Stormy (Darly) of Grand Prairie, Texas, Wilma (Gregory) of Baltimore, Maryland and Annie of Boston, Massachusetts; seventeen grandchildren, twenty great-grandchildren, three sisters-in-law, three brothers-in-law; a host of nieces and nephews; a close friend of many years, Jimmy Knox; other relatives and friends.
