Lee Grace Wade was born on December 25, 1945 in Fayetteville, NC to the late Art Burns and Alice Smith. She departed this life on April 7, 2015. She married Ernest Wade on December 31, 1964.

She received her education in the New York City public school system. Pursuing the dream to become an entrepreneur, she moved her family to Baltimore, Maryland and became self-employed as a child care provider. Lee Grace Wade provided quality child care at a reasonable rate which allowed her client base to grow. She included meals, extended hours, pick up/drop off service to and from school. Later she became a Personal Care Assistant for the State of Maryland. The position enabled her to travel to clients' homes to provide assistance with preparing meals and caring for the elderly and disabled. In total she spent 20 years providing care to the elderly and disabled and 40 years as a child care provider.

She was affectionately known as "Momma Grace" or "Ms. Grace" in the community where she lived for more than 40 years. Her demeanor was loving, friendly kind and gently. It was nothing for her to give her home to the homeless and to love the unloved. She was known for disciplining and mentoring the youth in her community. She was a great mother, role model and caretaker. Momma Grace was a great cook often times hosting cook outs, trips and holiday dinners to bring the family together under one roof. Her

dancing skills were often displaced during the festive celebrations she hosted at her home. She was truly a special woman and was loved by all she came in contact with.
