LELIA BLAND PRIVETTE, daughter of the late Walter Bland and Cora Jeffreys, was born on January 1, 1921 in Wake County, North Carolina. On Wednesday evening, July 23, 2014, Lelia quietly transitioned from her earthly dwelling place to her heavenly home. Lelia was educated in the Wake County Public School System. She served as a domestic worker for several years. For over 20 years, she owned a day care from her home. Lelia enjoyed caring for children. She always welcomed them into her house.

While living in North Carolina, in 1942 Lelia met and fell in love with Lumus Privette. They both decided to move to Baltimore, Maryland and on March 31, 1942, they were united in Holy Matrimony. They were married for 55 years. From this union they were blessed with one son, Lumus Privette Jr. She dressed JR to the "T".

Lelia was a very devoted wife and mother who enjoyed baking cakes and pies for her family. She was a firm believer and a devout prayer warrior who prayed for her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren daily.

Lelia was long time member of the Mt. Lebanon Baptist Church for over 20

years. The Lord guided her to become a faithful member of White Rock Non-Denominational Church in 2000, where she served on the Mother's Board until her passing.
