



## LeNora Alexander Jennings

LeNora Rebecca Alexander Jennings, daughter of the late William McKinsey and Rebecca Randolph Alexander, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, March 8, 2011. LeNora was born in Henderson, North Carolina. She was the 7th of eleven children. Eight siblings preceded her in death (Walter, John, Aubrey, Vestella, Herman, Theodore, Thomas and William.) Of the eleven siblings, two remain to cherish her memory, Alice A. Brooks and Charles F. Alexander.
