



## Lenora Davis Williams

September 27, 1919 - April 4, 2016

LENORA DAVIS WILLIAMS, one of sixteen children born to the late Robert Hankin Davis and Mary Henderson Johnson Davis, was born in Jackson, Northampton County, North Carolina on September 27, 1919. She entered into eternal rest on Monday, April 4, 2016 in Baltimore, Maryland.

Lenora received her education through the Northampton County School System. She also attended the Saint Paul Institute of Nursing and received a certificate of Home Nursing. After leaving the home nursing field, she worked in food service for the Baltimore City Public Schools with her last place of employment being Frederick Douglass High School.

Early on in life, Lenora sought Christ as her personal Saviour and joined Roanoke Chapel Baptist Church in Jackson, North Carolina. After moving to Baltimore she joined Fountain Baptist Church where she served on the Nurses Guild and Good Shepherd Baptist Church where she was a Deaconess. She later became one of the founding members of North Star Baptist Church where she was the Financial Secretary and served on the Deaconess Board and choir.

In 1947 she met the late James Williams of Elams, North Carolina and two years later on January 6, 1949 the two were married. This union lasted sixty-five years until his passing on October 31, 2014.

She was preceded in death by 14 siblings to include Rebecca Bailey, Cornelius Davis, Noah Davis, Lillie Mae Lowe, Rovella Watson and Earlene Starks. She was also preceded in death by her son, William A. Thomas.
