



## Leon Reynolds, Sr.

January 9, 1939 - June 3, 2014

Leon Reynolds Sr. was born on January 9, 1939 in Dora, Alabama to the late Mr. Leonard Reynolds Sr., and Jettie B. Reynolds Taylor. He was called home on June 3, 2014 after an extended illness. He was preceded in death by his sister, Mary Hudson and his youngest son, Keith Reynolds, Sr.

Leon attended Dora High School in Dora, Alabama where he excelled in numerous sporting events. Upon his graduation in 1958, Leon enlisted in the United States Army where he served meritoriously for 23 years, rising to the rank of Master Sergeant. During his time in the army, Leon served with honor and distinction as a communications chief and recruiter. Leon was awarded the Bronze Star Medal and the Vietnam Gallantry Cross for accomplishing deeds of valor and heroic conduct while fighting the enemy. He was also awarded the Master Parachutist Badge with Bronze Star, the Combat Infantryman Badge, and numerous other awards for distinction and meritorious service for his country. Upon retiring from the Army Leon continued serving his country and fellow servicemen for an additional 21 years by working for the Veterans Administration as a communications supervisor. Leon was an avid fisherman with a love of boating and sports cars.

Leon leaves to treasure his memory his devoted wife, Joyce Reynolds, two sons, Leon (Sonya) Reynolds, Jr., and Vaughn (Tonja) Reynolds; one-stepson, Henry Conyon, Jr. (Donna); two brothers, Leonard (Lottie) Reynolds
