Leon Lamont Wells, Jr., also referred to as “Monty” by close family and friends was born on February 21, 1968 to the union of Leon Wells Sr. and Ethel Wells in Richmond, Virginia.

Leon Lamont Wells, Jr. received his formal education in the Henrico County Public School System, graduating from Highland Springs High School, located in Highland Springs, Virginia in 1986. He loved the Lord and was baptized at the 6th Mount Zion Baptist Church, Richmond, Virginia.

Leon married Nina Fitzhugh, February 15, 1991. She preceded him in death on June 28, 2018.

Soft-spoken and even-tempered, God blessed Leon with a myriad of talents. He was a gifted songwriter, self-taught instrumentalist and vocalist, and he used those gifts to uplift the name of his Lord and Savior. He would take his passion for music and go on to organize a contemporary gospel group, “More Than Conquerors,” that traveled throughout Virginia, spreading the gospel through songs. Leon also possessed a unique flair for cooking, meal preparation, and cuisine presentation.

For over 20 years, he worked in the Hospitality and Hotel Management field for several reputable high-end hotel establishments, as well as launching his

own catering business "Revelations." As an entrepreneur, he co-founded the Kingdom Publishing Group, Inc, in 2000 where he served as President/CEO for 20 years. His company helped many budding authors and musical artists fulfill their dreams of getting their products out to the public by guiding them through the production, marketing, and distribution processes.

Leon will be remembered for his easy-going demeanor, humility and infectious smile. An avid sports fan who could be seen often wearing Washington Redskin's apparel. He was a man of great patience, quiet strength, and was always willing to lend a helping hand to those in need. When asked how he was able to remain calm in situations where most would lose all decorum, he responded "Sometimes you have to let some things ride."
