



Leonard W Boazmond

December 4, 1946 - June 26, 2023

LEONARD WILLIAM BOAZMOND was born in Baltimore, Maryland on December 4, 1946. He was the fourth child born to William Boazmond and Daisy Gurry. He departed this earth on June 26, 2023.

He received his education in the Baltimore City Public School System, where he completed 12th grade.

When Leonard was 9, he, his sister (Carrie Roberts), and his younger brother (James Martin) went into foster care under Raymond and Louise Cotton. They attended St. Paul Community Church on the corner of Wolfe and Federal Streets. Living with the Cottons, they found God and became the Angelic Gospel Singers, touring from church to church.

Leonard met Vida on August 14, 1973, in Cherry Hill where he worked for Regional Management, Inc. They met through a friend of Vida's. That same day they knew that they liked each other. When they got off from work, her girlfriend asked her to ride with her and her boyfriend, Leonard and two other friends road to downtown Baltimore so they could drop them off. Leonard felt protective of Vida and he warned his friends not to hit on her. By the time they reached downtown Baltimore in front of the Hecht Company, they knew they liked each other. He helped her out of the car, and kissed her in the middle of Howard St. and they knew that something was going on. They were going

together for seven years. And on May 8, 1980, they got married at Clarence Mitchell Courthouse and devoted their lives to each other for 43 years. They traveled a lot with a group on bus trips and cruises. He loved Atlantic City. Later on, he got ill and decided to stay at home. He started playing Scratch Offs daily. First thing in the morning, he would wake up, clean up and go purchase his scratchoffs.

Preceding him in death are his youngest brother, James Martin, second brother Lonnie Roberts, and oldest Alfred Paxton. Leonard leaves to mourn: his wife, Vida Boazmond; son, Laquin Kane; sister, Carrie Hubbard; granddaughter, Mehgan Kane; sisters-in-law, Rena Kenely, Gina Forman (Isaiah), Iris Chase, Yvette Hardy; and host of nieces and nephews.
