Leroy A. Coleman, Jr., son of the late Thomas Leroy and Geneva Coleman, was born on October 7, 1934 in Baltimore, Maryland. On October 9, 2001, he went quietly home to be with the Lord. Leroy, better known to his friends as "Horsey," received Christ at an early age. He received his education in the Baltimore City Public Schools. He was enlisted in the Air Force Reserve from 1952 until 1960. He was employed by Sparrows Point, followed by Embassy Delvale Ice Cream Company, and then Louis Dreyfus as a spouter for thirteen years until his retirement in 1985. He married Joyce Blackwell, and they had six children (three of whom preceded him in death, Daryl, Kelvin and Leroy). From his second marriage with Barbara Fayall came one daughter. He had two other wives who preceded him in death, Adeline Jennie and Lee Gray. Leroy loved jazz, watching sports and entertaining friends.
