LEROY ADAMS, son of the late Isaac Adams and Carrie Adams (Teel) was born on May 22, 1934 in Bethel, North Carolina. He departed this life on January 3, 2021.

He grew up in Bethel, North Carolina where he attended Bethel High School in Pitt County, North Carolina.

He enlisted in the Navy on November 4, 1955 and was assigned to the U.S.S. Yosemite. He was awarded two good conduct metals, first and second awards on November 3, 1958, and was honorably discharged on June 16, 1959.

After much travel, he married his longtime sweetheart, Elizabeth Smith in Holyoke, Massachusetts on April 17, 1965, and from this union, two children were born, Eric Adams and Lisa Adams.

He later moved to Baltimore, Maryland, and became a fulltime employee of Westinghouse (Northrup Grumman). He received awards and accolades for timeliness and punctuality that lasted the duration of his employment. He retired from Westinghouse (Northrup Grumman) after 28 years of service. loved to bowl and was a lifelong lover of music. He loved to read and learning new things. He took pleasure in reselling antiques and thrift items. He loved going to the gun range to improve his shooting skills. He was a talented harmonica player and loved performing at our family reunions.

He was dedicated to worship, tithing and regular communing at New Shiloh Baptist Church for 49 years.

Leroy was preceded in death by his wife Elizabeth Adams. He leaves to mourn: one son, Eric Adams (Vivian) and one daughter, Lisa Adams; two sisters, Linda Joyce Adams, Greensboro, North Carolina and Velma Bratton, Thomasville, North Carolina and a host of nieces, nephews and friends.
