His discharge rank was class Petty officer. He was employed at the University of MD School for over twenty-five years. He was also a faithful supporter of Oblate Sisters of Providence. On Friday, March 16, 2007 at 12:06 p.m. Leroy gave up this life for the peace he so desperately desired in which he lived.
