Leroy Leslie Kelly, Sr. age 77 of 3919 Pinalto Drive in Richmond, Virginia, departed this life on Friday, October 3, 2007 at the McGuire Veterans Hospital. He was born on April 15, 1931 to James Henry Kelly, Sr. and Mary Etta Kelly of Richmond, Virginia. Leroy was the third child of five children born of this union. He was preceded in death by a daughter Margie McCann and a son Dean Kelly. Leroy had two brothers, James H. Kelly, Jr., Richard W. Kelly, Sr. and two sisters, Sarah K. Strothers and Lena Kelly who also preceded him in death. Leroy attended Richmond Public Schools and received his GED in 1960, Leroy then completed one year of college while serving his country. Upon returning from his tour in 1972, Leroy began his civilian career as a security officer for the Bank of Virginia, then he went on to become a District Area Manager for all State and Federal Security with Wackenhut Security Agency. Leroy then moved on to become Captain of Security Personnel for Signet Bank for the remainder of his career. Leroy retired after 24 years of service in 1995. Leroy received his calling to God in 1973, where he was baptized and served as a devoted member of the Bethlehem Baptist Church in Richmond, Virginia. Leroy served under the leadership of Rev. John B. Gordon and Dr. Victor L. Davis. Brother Kelly continued his service to God as an active member of the Usher Board from 1973 through 1977. He also served his community as Scout Master for the Boy Scouts of America in 1974. In June of 2004, he accepted his certificate of membership from First Union Baptist Church, under the leadership of Dr. Henry C. McNeill. Leroy also

joined the Mason's Association where he served as a member of Lodge 41 for 25 years. Leroy was also a member of the Human Society and a member of the American Legion-Department of Virginia. He leaves to cherish his memory a devoted companion, Mrs. Peggy C. Kelly, his children, Donald L. Lucas (Delores), Leroy L. Kelly Jr., Margaret E. Kelly, Maxine K. Blunt (Gerald) and Dalemarie Andrews (Allen); nine grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren, a host of other relatives and friends.
