Leroy passed away on December 7th 2022 at the age of 76. He is survived by his sister Portia McCargo (Lomax), brother Michael Lomax, son Kevin Lomax, grandsons Mark Kaleb and Kody Lomax, niece Angela McCargo and numerous cousins and friends.
